#### **Food Pantries**

#### **Satellites**

Our Satellite Food Banks operate in partnership with community organizations around Thurston County. Each satellite distributes a pre-packaged assortment of groceries and/or offers a shopping model. Regular food service options include fresh produce, bakery items, ready-to-eat items, frozen meat or plant based-protein, and shelfstable items.

Please understand that using our Satellites counts towards your twice a month "full" visits and once a week "supplemental" visits.

## **CLIENT SERVICES**

In addition to our regular food service, clients may be eligible to receive food from two different federal programs: CSFP and SNAP (see below for information about these programs). Our Client Services Team can help determine if you are eligible and can assist with applications for these programs, either in person or by mail. Applicants for both programs must meet income requirements. CSFP applicants must also show proof of residency in Lewis, Mason or Thurston counties. Assistance is also provided if you are unhoused.

#### **CSFP for Seniors**

Commodities Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) serves seniors age 60+ who meet income eligibility requirements (verified annually). Eligible participants receive a 35-40 pound box of shelf-stable food each month that contains: peanut butter, cheese, cereal, rice/pasta, dried beans, juice, shelf-stable milk, canned meat, veggies, and fruit. 
