

Satellites

Our Satellite Food Banks operate in partnership with community organizations who serve as host sites and coordinate site volunteers.

Each satellite distributes a pre-packaged assortment of groceries, offers a choice shopping model, or offers a hybrid with some items pre-packaged and a selection for other items like produce. Available options generally include fresh, frozen, and dry goods/shelf-stable items.

Using a satellite location counts towards your twice a month Full visits or once a week Supplemental visit, depending on the options you select. As a general rule, visits that include frozen or dry goods count as a full visit.

Some satellites also have TEFAP (The Emergency Food Assistance Program) foods; these foods can be requested in addition to full or supplemental visit items, and can even be requested if you are out of full visits for the month. This federally funded program has income guidelines based on household size; no proof of income is needed, you will be asked to self-declare if you meet the guidelines.

Lacey & Olympia Food Pantries

Our Olympia and Lacey Food Pantries offer an indoor grocery shopping experience with the opportunity to choose among varieties of most items.

There are two types of visits: full or supplemental. The type of visit determines what items or areas you can choose from. Full visits are available two times a month and include shelf stable items, like canned goods, frozen items, and fresh items. Supplemental visits are available once a week and include fresh items like bread and produce.

Gluten free and vegan options are typically available for those with dietary restrictions. Ask about them when you check in.

Parents can request a variety of baby food, toddler food, and formula. Formula can be requested during either type of visit.

Both pantries offer cleaning and personal care products that can be picked up one time a month during a full visit. These products are called 'Other Bank'.

Pet food, diapers, menstrual products, and incontinence products are also available during a full visit, but may be out of stock, based on inventory.
